Startup Grant Application

\$1000-\$2000

New businesses opening in the Springfield Downtown Development Authority (DDA) Area can receive start up grants from \$1000 - \$2000. These funds will be granted to applicants that open a business and create new jobs in the DDA area. Jobs added to expanding businesses in the DDA area or businesses relocating to the DDA area are allowed to apply, provided that the new jobs were created and not already located in the DDA area. Applicants will receive up to \$1000 per employee, with a \$2000 max per business, and can be submitted anytime throughout the year. Contractual and/or 1099 persons are not eligible for grant funds. Applications will be approved based on set evaluation criteria and grant funds available.

Qualifications for Startup Grant Applications:

- Qualifying Employees must work at minimum of 20 hours/week each.
- Business must create at least one new job (this can include the owner's job).
- Business must have up to date business license.
- Business must be in the DDA area.
- Business must have a storefront in the DDA area that is occupied a minimum of 30 hours per week.
- Business must pledge to remain open at that location for at least one year.
- Grant funds will be available 90 days after the application is approved.
